www.one-ticket.co.uk The One-Ticket is a single ticket for bus and train travel. You can buy a day ticket for buses only, or a weekly/monthly/annual season ticket to allow you to take any local bus or train at any time. Tickets are available from all staffed train stations. **PlusBus or Tram**

Did you know that when you buy your train ticket to Edinburgh you can add on citywide bus or tram travel for £3? This is the same price as LRT's DAYticket and First's FirstDay ticket, but allows you to choose to travel with either company, or any of the smaller Edinburgh bus operators. And if you are a railcard holder you can buy it for only £2, which is cheaper than either of the day saver tickets. Bargain! PlusBus or Tram is available for other cities too, but you have to specify which one when you buy it. TripshareEastLothian

Taking your bike?

CrossCountry:

2 spaces per train can be reserved - call **0844 811 0124.** One bike without a reservation can be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Free.

East Coast: Reservations should be made at the station at least 24 hours before travel. Bikes may not be carried without a reservation. You can also make a reservation at the same time as buying your tickets online. Max 5 bikes per train (carried in the guard's van). Free. **Scotrail:** Up to 10 spaces per train at the guard's discretion. Free.

All trains will accept folding bikes as hand-luggage.
